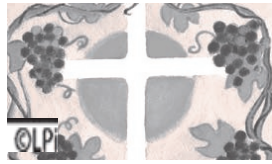

Pastor's Message

Fifth Sunday of Easter



The brainwashing of our original sin has made us feel ostracized from the Almighty, but our hearts are vehicles through which the vine of the Holy Spirit can spring up. Our branches of this grapevine can attach us to the gratifying gravy train which consists of the Fruits of the Holy Spirit, but we need to prune the vine with our penitence so as to enable it to grow more perfectly. It is possible for us to belong to the Beloved because Jesus planted this vine in our hearts to put the Fruits of love, joy and peace on our plates and enable us to treat one another with patience and kindness. Jesus can light the fire of love in our hearts because He is the gardener of the Holy Ghost and, by the grace of the Cross, He can turn our hearts into spiritual greenhouses. Jesus can spur on our branches of the vine to grow high and reach for the sky because our branches of the vine possess a receptacle which gives each of us a reciprocal relationship with the Redeemer. The growth spurt comes to us through the New Alliance and can make our hearts gush with love. So let's use this contract of contrition and plug into the divine power source. Let's get rid of the garbage in our gardens and give our branches of the vine room to grow on the arbor of our ardent love of God.

Enfrente de la Iglesia, hacia la derecha del campanario, verá una **puerta de hierro** que entra al vestíbulo de la Capilla. El Espíritu Santo (palomas) y Cristo (Chi Rho) están rodeados por una enredadera de uvas, ambos representan el primer milagro de Jesús (cambiando agua por vino) y la Eucaristía (cambiando vino en Su Sangre).



A la izquierda hay tres placas. La primera nos dice de la vida de **San Jorge, nuestro patrón**; la segunda es la conmemoración de la dedicación del 2010 mencionando a los participantes principales; y la tercera una breve historia de la Iglesia Católica de Saint George.



Inmediatamente a la derecha está la estatua de **Nuestra Señora de Fátima, Reina del Rosario**, rodeada por los niños (Lucía, Francisco y Jacinta) a los cuales les apareció en Portugal en 1917.
